

COURSE/PROGRAME OUTCOME OF DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

The College offers Undergraduate Honours and General Course in History. The outcomes of this course are as follows. Students who complete the History Honours might come up the following knowledge and skills.

CO-1- Learn basic narrative of historical events, evolution of human civilization, sources of historical writings & historical interpretations with special reference to gender, environment technology and regions.

CO-2- Understand the evolution of human civilization social formation & cultural pattern of the ancient world.

CO-3- Learn social formation , economic condition, changing political formation and feudal condition from 300 BC to 300 AD

CO-4- Familiarizes the students with social formations & cultural patterns of the medieval world viz: Roman Republic, economic development in Europe from the 7th to 14th centuries, religion of medieval world & Societies in Central Islamic lands.

CO-5- Encompasses studying Early Medieval India, Political structure, Agrarian structure & Social change, Trade & Commerce, Religion & Cultural developments.

CO-6- Introduces the transition from feudalism to capitalism, early colonial expansion, Renaissance & Reformation & economic development of 16th Century world.

CO-7- Acquaints the students with interpretation of sources of the Delhi Sultanate, Political structure, Emergence of Provincial identities, society & Economy, Religion, Society & Culture.

CO-8- Introduces the students with the 17th century European Crisis, the English Revolution, Rise of modern Science, Mercantilism & the American Revolution.

CO-9- Seeks to equip the students with the sources of historiography of Moghul India, Expansion & Integration of the Mogul Empire, Rural Society & Economy & Political & Religious Ideas.

CO-10- Trains the student on historical theories and methods meaning & scope of history, historical writing from ancient Greeks to western philosophers, history as interdisciplinary practice & modern theories.

CO-11- Introduces the students with the French Revolution & its fundamental impact on the world politics, Capitalist industrialization & social-economic transformation from late 18th C to 1914 CE.

CO-12-Exposes the manner of socio-economic condition & political fragmentation before the coming of Britisher to India & consolidation of colonial power in India, colonial Ideology, rural economy & Society & Popular resistance.

CO-13- Familiarize the students with the cultural changes, Socio-religions movements of modern India trends of nationalism up to 1919, Gandhian nationalism after 1919, Ideas & movements, Communalism & partition emergence of a new state & making of the constitution of India.

CO-14- Acquaints the students with the liberal democratic government working class movements, socialism in 19th & 20th Century modern europe, crisis of feudalism in Russia & experiments in socialism, Imperialism, war & crisis from C 1880 to 1939, Cultural & Intellectual traditions since Circa 1850.

SEC-I- Introduces the students with the cultural heritage of India vis-a-vis Odisha & its significance in modern times.

SEC-II-Introduces the students with the popular cultural traits expressed in different mediums like visual , oral, fair, festivals & naturals.

DSE-I-Familiarizes the students with the history of United State of America from C.1776-1945 – making of the Republic, evolution of American democracy, early capitalism agrarian south & civil war.

DSE-II-Caters information on the history & culture of early medieval Odisha, Its Socio-economic life, Religion , Art & literature, political & economic structure, colonialism in Odisha & Socio-cultural changes in Modern Odisha.

DSE-III- Introduces the students with the history of the United states of America from C. 1776 to 1945 like Political charges and agrarian transform actions, Resistance & reform, vs Imperialism, Afro-American Movements, Socio-Religions cultural & Intellectual movements.

Project- Equips the students with the art of writing a project paper .
