Resolution-16

The 16th meeting of the Academic council was held on 10/12/2021 at 11 a.m. in the Conference Hall of the College under the Chairmanship of Dr. Rajendra Prasad Tripathy, Principal of the College. At the outset, Dr. Tripathy extended warm welcome to the members and after due formalities, the proceedings of last academic council meeting were read out by Dr. Pravakar Mallick, teacher-in-charge UGC. Dr. P.K. Das co-ordinator IQAC presented the action taken report of the last meeting. The proceedings of last academic council meeting was unanimously approved.

The meeting proceeded as per the agenda and after discussion the following resolutions were adopted.

- The revised syllabi (CBCS) for +3 Arts, Science and Commerce streams and PG in Sociology for 2021-22 admission batch as prepared by the Board of studies were approved.
- The Subject wise list of Question setters, moderators and examiners (Theory and practical)
 for different Semesters as suggested by the Board of Studies were approved. The Honours
 wise degree results as placed by Mr. R.C. Patra, controller of examinations was discussed
 and approved.
- 3. The Academic calendar of the college for the session 2021-22 was presented by the Academic Bursar, Dr. D.N. Gochhayat and after discussion it was approved unanimously.
- 4. Prof. B.K. Mallick, Hon'ble member, nominee of vice-chancellor in his speech laid stress on (a) To make the campus clean, (b) To enhance research activity and (c) to develop impressive infrastructure. He advised to change the syllabus up to the maximum limit of 15% keeping local requirements in view. Besides this, he suggested to open add on courses for creating employable opportunities among the learners. He said that the mentor-mentee system should be held periodically to develop inter personal relationship with the students.
- 5. Prof. P.K. Pradhan, another nominee of vice-chancellor stressed upon the maintaining of records of successful alumni. The achievements of successful alumni of each department should be recorded. He stressed upon the documentation of day-to-day activities of the college in the website. In his address he said that college is not merely a degree producing centre but we must try to make the institution a life making institution. He advised to felicitate the best alumni for their commendable achievement. Besides this, he reiterated to stick to the academic calendar as far as practicable. Project works should be allotted to the students before the beginning of the 6th semester, so that students would get sufficient time to complete the project work in due time. He advised to increase the number of smart class rooms in order to make the teaching more impressive.
- 6. Dr. N.N. Sharma, Hon'ble member laid stress on undertaking extension activities such as cybercrime, rood safety, environmental awareness etc. which will be beneficial for the society. He suggested to prepare an annual booklet of student seminars held at different times. He also suggested to develop pisciculture in the campus.
- 7. Mr. Saroj Raj Singh, Hon'ble member advised to open up job-oriented courses in addition to traditional courses.
- 8. Dr. N. Parida, Hon'ble member stressed upon athletic activity and told to activate the health centre in the campus. He also suggested to boost the NSS activities to be linked with local people. He suggested that it would be better to impart general knowledge during their normal classes, so that the students can be better competent in the competitive examinations.

Finally, the meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks to the chair and other members present by Prof. G.C. Behera, vice-principal of the college.
